The Allen School of Health Sciences firmly believes in providing educational training opportunities to students who are in need of assistance to achieve their educational and career goals with the hopes of achieving their personal and professional life goals. In accordance with this institutional philosophy, the Allen School of Health Sciences is pleased to offer scholarship opportunities to students who meet the criteria.

Dream Act Scholarship Requirements - \$6,000 per student

- Completion of Dream Act Scholarship Form
- Completion of Scholarship Application Form and approval
- Completion of a formal Career Planning Session
- Completion of all Admissions Requirements
- Eligibility to work in the United States
- *Up to \$100,000 will be awarded yearly

Military Member Scholarship Requirements - \$1,500 per student

- Completion of Military Member Scholarship Form
- Completion of Scholarship Application Form and approval
- Completion of a formal Career Planning Session
- Completion of all Admissions Requirements
- Students must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- DD214 or other document showing current or former membership to Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps,
 Coast Guard or National Guard
- *Up to 2 scholarships will be awarded yearly

Presidential Scholarship - \$1,500 per student

- Completion of Presidential Scholarship Form
- Completion of Scholarship Application Form and approval
- Completion of a formal Career Planning Session
- Completion of all Admissions Requirements
- High School transcript showing student graduated High School less than 18 months before start date
- Transcript proving student received at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA upon graduation of High School
- *Up to 2 scholarships will be awarded yearly

Workforce Scholarship - \$4,000 per student

- Completion of Workforce Scholarship Form
- Completion of a Scholarship Application Form and approval
- Completion of a Formal Career Planning Session
- Completion of all Admissions Requirements
- Proof of approval of a Workforce Innovation and Opportunity act Grant of \$4000.
- Eligibility to work in the United States
- *Up to \$100,000 will be awarded yearly

Prospective scholarship recipients must submit an application including an essay and other required documents for review by the Scholarship Committee.
