Phoenix High School and Military Scholarship Criteria

- Students must have applied and been accepted for admission at the Allen School of Health Sciences
- Scholarships may be applied to tuition only
- Students must have completed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine eligibility (International students are exempt from this requirement)
- Scholarships applications can only be submitted for one award to one program at the Allen School of Health Sciences
- 2 students per year will receive the High School and 2 will receive the Military
- Scholarship amount is \$1,500
- Applications are accepted until 30 days before the start of the program. Funds are limited so applicants are encouraged to apply early.
- Applicants will be accepted based on the decision of the 3-member scholarship committee

High School Presidential Scholarship: For students having graduated high school within one year of their program start date who have demonstrated financial need (as defined by the Expected Family Contribution from the FAFSA) and outstanding academic performance in high school. Graduating GPA requirement is 3.0

Military Member Scholarship: For students who are current or former members of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, or National Guard who have demonstrated financial need (as defined by the Expected Family Contribution from the FAFSA)

Any service member if discharged must have been discharged under conditions other than dishonorable
